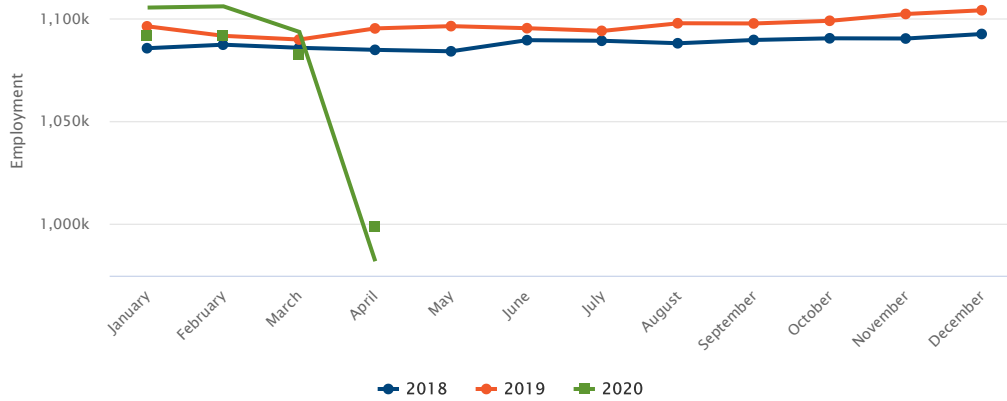

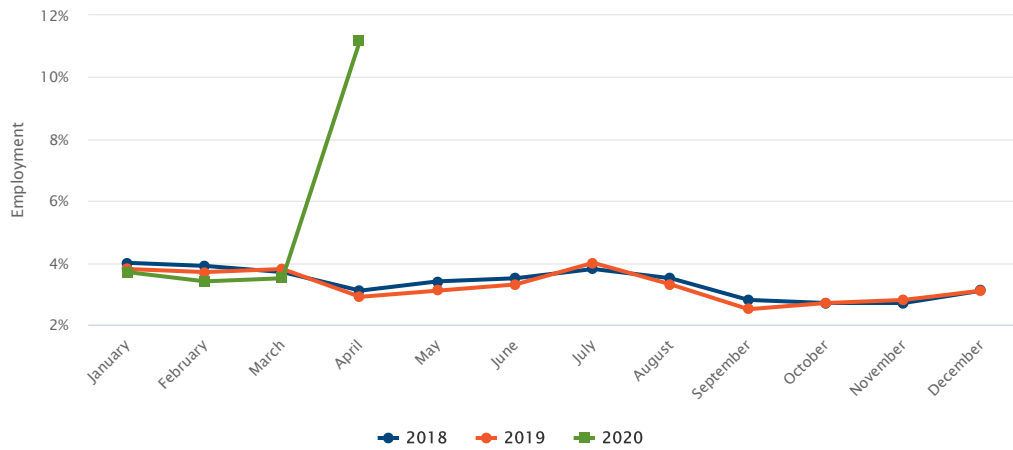

## Unemployment

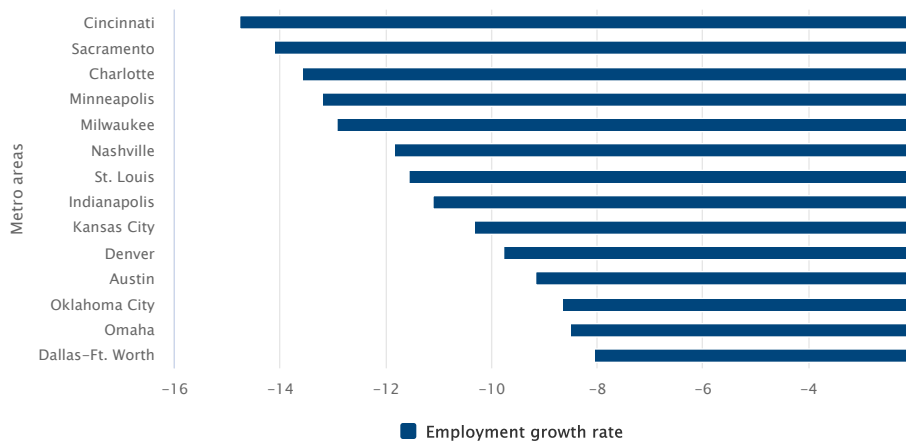
The number of unemployed as a percent of the total labor force, not seasonally adjusted.
